

Philippians – Finding Joy in All Circumstances

Week 4 – Key Verse – *Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Philippians 2:9-11*

This week we start looking at Philippians 2 which is packed full of truth and doctrine. I hope you enjoy digging into this chapter.

1. From Philippians 2:1-2, Paul desires to have his joy made complete. What is our responsibility from verse 2?
 - a. How do you see Jesus as fully God?
 - b. How do you see Jesus as fully man?
2. If you have been in church, you may have heard the phrase that Jesus was “fully God and fully man.” Philippians 2:5-11 is a beautiful explanation of this.
 - a. How do you see Jesus as fully God?
 - b. How do you see Jesus as fully man?
3. The word *obedient* in verse 8 means to “listen attentively”.
 - a. To what extent did Christ become obedient?
 - b. What attitude was necessary for His obedience?
 - c. What was God’s response to Christ’s obedience?
4. The words *highly exalt* in verse 9 mean to “raise to supreme majesty”.
 - a. In what two ways will mankind someday respond to Jesus Christ?
 - b. What will mankind’s response bring to the God?
